Valedictorian and Salutatorian of the Senior Class

At Veritas Collegiate Academy, the qualifications for Valedictorian and Salutatorian are based on academic excellence and overall achievement.

<u>The Valedictorian</u> is the student with the highest weighted GPA, as indicated on the mid-year transcript of the senior year, in the graduating class, demonstrating exceptional academic performance across a range of subjects.

<u>The Salutatorian</u> is the student with the second-highest weighted GPA as indicated on the mid-year transcript of the senior year, also excelling academically.

Both titles recognize outstanding students who embody the values of scholarship, and dedication to their education over the years they attended Veritas.

Please note, student must have completed all academic requirements within the time frame student was in attendance. Also, the student must be matriculated as a full-time student at Veritas (or one of its affiliated campuses) for at least the 2 years prior to graduation (including senior year).

- Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be announced sometime prior to graduation.
- All other grades and credits following the 1st semester will not be factored in the GPA for Valedictorian or Salutatorian, unless a significant change in grades occur.
- Demerits, behavior, and adherence to school policy and procedures will also be taken into account when choosing Valedictorian and Salutatorian.
